Northwest Kidney Centers is a regional, not-for-profit provider of kidney dialysis, public health education, and research into the causes and treatments of chronic kidney disease. Founded in Seattle in 1962, it was the world's first dialysis organization. It is known for high-quality services, deep community connections and generous donor support.

#### Our mission

To promote the optimal health, quality of life and independence of people with kidney disease through patient care, education and research.
