In 2022 Northwest Kidney Centers will mark its 60th anniversary as the world's first outpatient dialysis provider. On Jan. 9, 1962, we opened our doors as the Seattle Artificial Kidney Center in Eklind Hall on the campus of Swedish Hospital with the capacity to treat 3 patients. Fast forward to today and we serve nearly 2,000 patients annually at 20 clinics in the Puget Sound region.





Northwest Kidney Centers is a regional, not-for-profit provider of kidney dialysis, public health education, and research into the causes and treatments of chronic kidney disease. Founded in Seattle in 1962, it was the world's first dialysis organization. It is known for high-quality services, deep community connections, and generous donor support.
