KIDNEY RESEARCH

Research has fueled our work since the very beginning. From developing the world's first home dialysis program to introducing revolutionary new treatments, our progress is rooted in the pioneering work of doctors and scientists.

Together with the UW Medicine, we established the Kidney Research Institute and the Center for Dialysis Innovation. The Kidney Research Institute is a world leader in clinical research, with a focus on innovation and discovery. The Center for Dialysis Innovation aims to use biomaterial and bioengineering technologies to transform dialysis care.



KIDNEY PALLIATIVE CARE

Northwest Kidney Centers introduced the world's first palliative care program for dialysis patients in 2017.

Palliative care is specialized medical care for people with serious illnesses. It focuses on minimizing pain, symptoms and stress of the illness and addresses the emotional, spiritual and psychological sides of disease. The goal is to improve quality of life for both the patient and the family and can be provided along with curative treatment.
