What you need to know for your first dialysis treatment with us:

When:	Your first treatment: Arrive at: Dialysis time: to
	You will review and sign paperwork first, then have a dialysis treatment. You will be given your schedule for following treatments. Call unit if you can't make it.
You <i>must</i> bring:	Picture ID
	Insurance cards
	List of medications or pill bottles
	Discharge instructions if you are just getting out of the hospital Glasses, hearing aid, walker, wheelchair, cane; if you use them
You may bring:	Washable blanket, pillow with washable cover
	Light snack
	Another adult (can stay with you during your treatment)
What to wear:	Comfortable clothing
	If you have a catheter in your chest, clothing must open in the front so staff can work with your catheter.
	If you have a fistula or graft in your arm, clothing must allow it to be uncovered.
Transportation:	Transportation is your responsibility. There are services out there that can help with this, you can ask your unit for more information on this subject.
